Little Rangers

Ages 3 & 4 • Runs Sessions 1-8

A weekly calendar of camp activities will be distributed at the beginning of each session and will detail the trip.

Entering Grade 9-10 • Runs Sessions 1-4 and Sessions 5-8

Our future leaders, Counselors-In-Training, spend four weeks (Sessions 1-4 OR Sessions 5-8) training and working with campers and camp staff. They will learn to develop leadership skills, personal values, teambuilding and communication skills along the way. Counselors-In-Training also have the opportunity to become First Aid and CPR certified, and most of all, have fun and learn the ropes of being a counselor! Also a great way to fulfill volunteer hours for church or other community organizations. Candidates must fill out a CIT application and be interviewed by the CIT and Camp Directors. CIT applications are available at the Cheshire Community YMCA.

Craft Camp M campers participate in craft making sessions and swimming during the morning followed by activities in the afternoon. **NEW THIS YEAR:** Craft Camp M will also have the opportunity to plan and coordinate an arts & crafts project they can display at our first family night during week 4! Craft Camp M will go on one field trip, and it will be their very own craft-specific field trip! A weekly calendar will be sent home at the beginning of each week.

Craft Camp W

Grades 4-6 • Runs Sessions 7 & 8 • 2-week session

Craft Camp W campers participate in craft making sessions and swimming during the morning followed by activities in the afternoon. **NEW THIS YEAR:** Craft Camp W will also have the opportunity to plan and coordinate an arts & crafts project they can display at our second family night during week 8! Craft Camp W will go on one field trip, and it will be their very own craft-specific field trip! A weekly calendar will be sent home at the beginning of each week.

Sports Camp

Grades 1-3 • Runs Sessions 1-8 • 2-week sessions

Sports Camp emphasizes the basic skills and rules of a variety of sports, while instilling good sportsmanship and having fun. Campers spend their time playing a variety of different sports each morning, as well as swimming and other activities in the afternoon. **NEW THIS YEAR:** Sports Campers will go on one field trip per session, and it will be their very own sports-specific field trip! A weekly calendar will be sent home at the beginning of each week.

NEW! Adventurers

Grades 4-6 • Runs Sessions 2-7

Adventurers is designed for campers who enjoy exploring nature and the outdoors. Adventurers will go on a different field trip each day, exploring the beautiful aspects of nature Cheshire has to offer. Just to name a few trips: Lock 12, the Linear Trail, Roaring Brook and other nature trails. As Adventurers explore Cheshire and parks just outside it, they will also have the opportunity to go swimming each day and participate in other camp activities. A weekly calendar will be sent home at the beginning of each week.

Swimming: Rascals, Mountaineers, Wranglers, Adventurers, Pathfinders, CITs and specialty camps all have the opportunity to swim at the Cheshire Academy Pool. Transportation is provided by YMCA Camp Quinnipiac to and from the pool. YMCA Camp Quinnipiac provides swimming 4 days a week (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday & Friday), and has a certified lifeguard staff at the pool at all swimming times.

Field Trips: Mountaineers, Wranglers, Pathfinders, CITs and specialty camps will participate in field trips which will be detailed in a weekly newsletter that will be distributed at the beginning of each week. All campers need a YMCA Camp Quinnipiac t-shirt for field trips. YMCA Camp Quinnipiac t-shirts can be purchased at the Cheshire Community YMCA or YMCA Camp Quinnipiac for \$8.00.

Family Night: YMCA Camp Quinnipiac invites all families to its Family Night on **Wednesday, July 21** - Session 4 and **Wednesday, August 18** - Session 8. Family Night is a great way for families to meet with their camper's counselor and enjoy an evening at YMCA Camp Quinnipiac. Family Night begins at 6 PM with a family cookout where food is provided by YMCA Camp Quinnipiac, and ends at 8 PM after skits and songs or other activities by campers and staff. All campers are invited to Family Night; we look forward to seeing you there!

2010 Pick Up & Drop Off Information

- Campers may be dropped off at Chapman School starting at 8:45 AM. The swim bus will leave by 9:15 AM.
- Before and after care will be held at Chapman School.
- Campers must be picked up at Chapman School starting at 3 PM.
- Parents must park in the front parking lot at Chapman School and walk to the back to sign child in and out.
- Bussing will be offered to camp for all campers from the Cheshire Community YMCA to YMCA Camp Quinnipiac. Children may be dropped

- off at the Cheshire Community YMCA beginning at 8:30 AM, and the bus will leave at 8:50 AM.
 - Only Little Rangers will be able to be transported back to the Cheshire Community YMCA from YMCA Camp Quinnipiac at the end of their day. They will need to be picked up no later 1:30 PM.
 - All campers who are taking the bus from the Cheshire Community YMCA to YMCA Camp Quinnipiac will need to sign up for the bus before their intended session of camp.

General Information

Important Information

YMCA Camp Quinnipiac is a state-licensed day camp. The camp day runs from 9 AM to 3 PM. Before Care runs from 7 AM to 9 AM. After Care runs from 3 PM to 6 PM. Little Rangers is a half day program that runs from 9 AM to 1 PM. There is no Before or After Care available for Little Rangers. Campers not participating in Before Care can be dropped off beginning at 8:45 AM. Campers not participating in After Care must be picked up by 3 PM.

Location

PLEASE NOTE LOCATION: YMCA Camp Quinnipiac takes place at Chapman School, 38 Country Club Road, Cheshire, CT.

Payment Schedule

All children enrolled in camp this summer need to have a current YMCA membership throughout their stay at camp. A **\$50.00** non-refundable deposit per session is required upon registration for camp. **Deposits are non-transferable after April 30, 2010.*** The remaining balance is due in full, two weeks prior to the start of each session. A \$15.00 late fee will be assessed on all payments made after the deadline. Please address all questions or concerns regarding camp payments to Karen Thuerk, at the Cheshire Community YMCA at 203-272-3150, ext. 307. **ALL CAMPERS MUST BE REGISTERED BY 3PM ON FRIDAY PRIOR TO THE SESSION STARTING.**

*Prior to May 1, 2010 deposits may be transferred to another session of camp.

Camp Improvement Fee

YMCA Camp Quinnipiac has a **\$10.00 non-refundable Camp Improvement Fee per child for the 2010 summer.** Last year's Camp Improvement Fee went towards the purchase of our Camp Quinnipiac sound system!

Before and After Care

Before and After Care is available for an additional fee of \$32.00 per week for Before Care; \$37.00 per week for After Care; and \$60.00 per week for both Before AND After Care. Before and After Care take place at Chapman School. Before Care runs from 7 AM to 8:45 AM and After Care runs from 3 PM to 6 PM. Before and After Care is NOT available for Little Rangers.

Financial Assistance

Medical Forms

State law requires that all campers have a medical form completed by a physician and submitted to the Cheshire Community YMCA within 3 years of the beginning of camp. *****MEDICAL FORMS ARE DUE THE WEDNESDAY PRIOR TO YOUR CHILD'S FIRST DAY OF CAMP.*****

Attire

Campers should bring a backpack, bathing suit, towel, water bottle, and lunch each day. Camper's name should be clearly marked on all belongings including clothing. Open toed sandals or shoes are not permitted at any time. Camp T-shirts are required for field trips and can be purchased at camp or the YMCA for \$8.00. Campers should apply sunscreen or bug repellent before coming to camp each morning. Campers that need to reapply during the day should bring the extra lotion to the Camp Nurse.

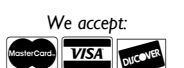
